This new programme is for projects that bring local people together to discover, enjoy and protect the wildlife in their local area.

Can I apply?

You can apply if you are a not-for-profit group, local council, school or health body.

How much can I get?

Between £300 and £10,000, for projects that can be finished within one year.





When can I get it?

There are three deadlines:

21 July 2010

22 September 2010

24 November 2010

What will it fund?

Projects that improve rural or urban environments for people to enjoy, for example by:

- protecting wildlife habitats
- creating a nature trail, woodland walk or wildlife garden for people to enjoy
- improving community spaces, such as rivers, ponds and woodlands.

Projects that get people more active and healthier, for example by:

- exploring parks, rivers and the countryside to look for rare or endangered species
- encouraging people to take up gardening or go on nature walks
- providing opportunities for children to learn about nature through play.
