NOTES ABOUT FORM UC1 - VOTING BY EUROPEAN UNION CITIZENS AT ELECTIONS OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT

If you are a Citizen of one of the European Union (EU) countries listed below, you can register to vote in the UK at a European Parliamentary election. Elections to the European Parliament take place every five years. The next election is scheduled for 4 June 2009.

If you are a citizen of the UK, Republic of Ireland, Malta or Cyprus, you are eligible to vote at all UK elections and so **do not** need to use this form. Ask the electoral registration office for an appropriate registration form if you are not already registered.

In order to register to vote, you must first be resident at an address in the United Kingdom.

Please read the following information before completing the form.

NOTES

1. A new electoral register is produced every year on 1 December. Names can be added and removed throughout the year. You can register to vote if you are 16 or over (but you cannot vote until your 18th birthday).
2. **This form only registers you for European parliamentary elections.** You should already have been included on the register of local electors by your electoral registration office. If you are not already registered, you can get a registration form for this purpose from your electoral registration office.
3. You cannot vote at European Parliamentary elections in more than one country. If you fill in this form, you are agreeing to vote in the UK only and **not** in your home country. But remember, you can cancel this registration up until 19 May 2009.
4. If you intend to vote in the European Parliamentary elections in your home country rather than the UK, **do not** complete this form.
5. Completing this form does not affect your voting rights for elections other than the European Parliamentary elections, either in the UK or your home country
6. Each person applying must fill in a separate form. If you need more forms, please photocopy this one, or contact us at the address below, or you can print copies from our website at www.babergh-south-suffolk.gov.uk
7. 9. When a European Parliamentary Election is held, a poll card will be sent to successful applicants at the address where they are registered, explaining where, when and how to vote.
10. This form must reach the electoral registration officer by **19 May 2009** to be effective for the election on 4 June.
