**Your attention is drawn to the following:**

**Para 40(1) of Schedule 11 to the 2005 Act:**

If after receiving a statement under paragraph 39 [of Schedule 11 to the 2005 Act] a Local Authority think that the lottery to which the statement relates was a large lottery, they shall notify the Gambling Commission in writing.

**Para 55 of Schedule 11 to the 2005 Act:**

This Statement shall be retained for a minimum of 18 months, and made available for inspection by members of the public at all reasonable times.

**Offences: Section 262 and section 342 of the 2005 Act:**

s.262: Purporting to operate a small society lottery when not registered, or failing to make the required, or making false or misleading, returns in respect of such lotteries.

s.342 Without reasonable excuse, giving false or misleading information to the Gambling Commission or Licensing Authority.

A person guilty of an offence under this part shall be liable upon summary conviction to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 51 weeks, a fine not exceeding level 5 on the standard scale, or both.
