Babergh Core Strategy and Modifications - Need for a new Hearing session

In the light of the representations related to the proposed Main Modifications to policy CS6a (Brantham Regeneration Area Allocation), specifically Proviso D and Map F, the Inspector considers the matter needs to be examined at a new Hearing session. The Inspector does not consider that consideration of written representations would be sufficient to examine the issues thoroughly.

The session will deal only with the Brantham site and will be held on Wednesday 25th September with a start of 10am. The venue is yet to be confirmed, but I will be investigating the possibility of using Brantham Parish Hall.

The Council will appreciate that this will inevitably delay the submission of the Inspectors report on the Core Strategy. The Inspector has asked me to make all the administrative arrangements for progressing the hearing session and he will give a revised timetable once matters have progressed further.
