Hi – thanks for considering to sign-up to one of our events, we hope you'll come along and get a lot of enjoyment during your time with us.

When signing up to an event we will need to take some personal information from you, things like your name and contact details so we can register you for the event of your choice, and keep you updated should any details about the event change. We'd also like to know your, age, postcode and which school you attend – this will help us in the future so we can make sure we plan events in the right areas, for the right age groups and enable as many schools as possible to get told about future events.

We also need to ask if there is anything concerning your health that we should be aware of which might impact on your ability to enjoy your time with us. For example, whether you're asthmatic, have allergies or mobility issues – that sort of thing.

Like anyone else whose information we take you have the right to know what we do with it once we have it – so let's have a look at a couple of examples now.

If you give us information about your health and mobility, we understand that this can be very sensitive to you, and we will only hold it with your consent. On the form you use to sign-up with if you fill in any information about your health and mobility you will be asked to 'tick-a-box' consenting for us to hold and share this information so we can ensure your needs are met. You'll also be told how to take your consent away if you so wish. If you don't give your consent to let us use your health and mobility information, we may not be able to look after you properly if an emergency occurred.

We won't keep hold of this information for long, in fact it will be deleted from our systems 7 days after the event is finished. Any feedback information you may provide after the event gathered for the purposes of evaluation and future planning will be kept for a period of 3 years.

Whilst we hold your information, we will keep it secure and only share it with who we need to, for example the venue where the event is taking place, so they know who to expect, and the people running the event, so they know your names and needs.
