Chelmondiston parish lies almost entirely within Suffolk Coasts and Heaths AONB and also has a Conservation Area in the historic Pin Mill coastal settlement. It is an important area for tourism and leisure, as well as agriculture. It is crucial that the balance of different pressures on the area is well managed, and we feel that a Neighbourhood Plan is necessary to reflect the sensitivity of the area and to provide sufficient detail to safeguard its value to the wider community as AONB and Conservation Area.
