



**Babergh and Mid Suffolk Joint Local Plan
Regulation 18 Consultation
Topic Paper – Settlement Hierarchy Review**

August 2017

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1. Introduction

- 1.1 This Topic Paper accompanies the Settlement Hierarchy section of the Babergh and Mid Suffolk Joint Local Plan: Consultation Document (August 2017) (hereafter referred to as the 'Consultation Document').
- 1.2 The purpose of this Topic Paper is to present additional detail and context surrounding the needs for different housing types and tenures across Babergh and Mid Suffolk.
- 1.3 As part of the preparation of the new Joint Local Plan for Babergh and Mid Suffolk District Councils, a review of the settlement hierarchy was carried out to reflect changes that have occurred over recent years and to ensure that the settlements are appropriately categorised in relation to the services and facilities they provide.
- 1.4 This study collates information on the services and facilities available in the 'larger' and 'smaller' villages of both districts. It updates the 2014 (for Babergh) and 2008 (for Mid Suffolk) studies carried out to inform the Core Strategies. This information is used to assess the relative sustainability of larger and smaller villages for policy-making purposes in relation to the new Joint Local Plan for Babergh and Mid Suffolk.
- 1.5 Within the current settlement hierarchies of Babergh and Mid Suffolk, higher order settlements such as the towns, core villages and key service centres are identified as the main locations to accommodate future growth. This study of the village facilities provides an evidence base for the classification of 'larger' and 'smaller' villages within the settlement hierarchy. The classification is based on the availability of, or access to, facilities and services, to indicate their relative sustainability as locations for some development.
- 1.6 The towns and urban areas of both districts that are not included within this exercise are listed below (including population as per Census 2011):
 - Eye (population of 2,154)
 - Hadleigh (population of 8,248)
 - Needham Market (population of 4,462)
 - Pinewood (population of 4,298)
 - Stowmarket (population of 19,277)
 - Sudbury and Great Cornard (population of 21,977)

2. Methodology

- 2.1 A Services and Facilities Audit was carried out over the summer of 2014 for Babergh and during the spring of 2017 for Mid Suffolk. This data was then used to develop a scoring system (detailed in Table 1) to rank each settlement. The aim is to use a simple points system, to provide a general understanding of the level of facilities and services available to each settlement.
- 2.2 The scoring is based on the relative importance of each facility available within a settlement, in that some services are more essential and used more frequently than others, such as a primary school or a convenience store. As these are important facilities that reduce the need to travel by car and support the vitality of the local community, they are given a score of 2 points. Other facilities such as a village hall or a recreation ground add to diversity and help build communities. Such facilities score 1 point, as they do not contribute as significantly to people's day to day needs.

2.3 Where a facility can be found within the built up area of the village, points are scored irrespective of the exact location of the facility. Where an adjacent village can make use of a facility i.e. it is within walking or cycling distance, that village can also score points for that particular service. Furthermore, some facilities are located quite a distance from any village but could still count if within walking or cycling distance.

2.4 The scoring matrix was developed using nine broad categories of criteria:-

- Banking / Post Office / Retail
- Community Centres
- Education

- Employment
- Medical
- Public Transport
- Recreation
- Internet Connectivity
- Proximity to other settlements

2.5 Each broad category includes individual criterion of a set score of either 1 or 2 points. An explanation of the score provided against each facility is set out below.

2.6 Banking / Post Office / Retail:

Convenience Store: A convenience store provides an essential service to a community and reduces the need to travel. It therefore grants a score of 2 points.

Post Office: A post office is also an important local service, however it is not generally used on a daily basis and therefore is given 1 point.

Food / Drink outlets / Public Houses: Food and drink outlets and public houses in particular are often considered to be a hub of a community, especially in rural settlements. They are also considered to contribute to the economy by providing local employment opportunities. However, as they are not considered to be an essential day to day facility, they are given a score of 1 point. Each of these facilities would be awarded 1 point, to a maximum total of 5 points.

Bakers / Butchers / Hairdressers / Newsagents / Bank / ATM / Fuel Station: These are all relatively important services that would be used regularly by the community. However, as they are not considered to be an essential day to day facility, they are given a score of 1 point. Each of these facilities would be awarded 1 point, to a maximum total of 5 points.

2.7 Community Centres:

Village Hall: Village halls provide a space for clubs, groups and community social events which can form an integral part of the community. They are a valuable facility and highly contribute to the vitality of a rural community. However, as they are not considered to be an essential day to day facility, they are given a score of 1 point.

Place of Worship: Places of worship are also given a score of 1 point, as they act as a hub for the community but are equally not considered to be an essential day to day facility.

Library: Permanent libraries provide a benefit to the community. Similarly to village halls, some permanent libraries also offer additional activities and clubs which strongly contribute to the vitality of a community. Only permanent libraries are being considered in this assessment, and are given a score of 1 point as they are not considered to be an essential day to day facility.

2.8 Education:

Pre-School: The availability of pre-school places is an important factor for parents. All children are entitled to 15 hours of funded childcare in a pre-school setting from the term after their third birthday. Local provision is seen as beneficial to encourage a sense of community for families with young children, and as such is a service considered by this assessment, and is given a score of 1 point.

Primary School: Primary schools provide for children from reception through to year 6. In rural communities especially, primary schools also contribute to promoting a sense of place and community, as they often act as a local community hub, with fund raising events such as summer fetes, Christmas Fairs, as well as vital links with the local village halls, libraries and places of worship. Primary Schools are also a regular day to day service and facility used by families with children under the age of 12 years old. Primary Schools are therefore given a score of 2 points.

Secondary School: Secondary schools provide for children from Year 7 through to Year 11. Secondary schools are often located in larger settlements and serve a wider community. They are therefore given a score of 1 point.

Sixth Form and Further Education: As with secondary schools, such provision is usually found in larger settlements and serve a wider community. These facilities are given a score of 1 point.

2.9 Employment

Proximity to a large scale employment site (within approximately 5km): Employment opportunities promote self-containment and act as a pull factor to draw people to areas. Having opportunities for employment close to where people live can also reduce the need to travel or the distance travelled. For the purposes of this exercise a large scale employment site is defined as an employer or group of employers providing 100 jobs. Proximity to large scale employment sites will be given 2 points.

Proximity to a small scale employment site (within approximately 5km): Small scale employment can offer a vital service within smaller settlements, promoting self-containment. A small scale employment site would be considered as providing up to 100 jobs, or in cases where a number of very small employers cumulatively provide a number of job opportunities for the area. In these cases 1 point is given.

2.10 Medical

Doctor surgery: Access to a doctors' surgery is often a concern within rural communities and this should be considered as a key service. It is therefore given a score of 2 points.

Chemist / pharmacy: The provision of a chemist/pharmacy plays an integral role in maintaining the health of the community and can provide valuable health care advice and services in the absence of a doctors surgery. This facility is therefore given a score of 2 points.

Dentist: As with the provision of a chemist/pharmacy, a dentist is a service beneficial to the overall healthcare provision that a settlement can offer. However dentists are usually used less frequently than doctors. A score of 1 point is given for this service.

Optician: As with the provision of a dentist, an optician is also beneficial to the overall healthcare provision of a settlement, but is normally used less frequently than a doctors or a pharmacy. A score of 1 point is also given for this service.

2.11 Public Transport

Bus Stops: Bus stops providing access to daily peak-time services to and from a higher order settlement, are given 2 points as they provide an important connection to other settlements as well as to education and employment opportunities, health care services, etc.

Railway Station: Railway stations with daily peak-time services to and from a higher order settlement, are also given 2 points due to the benefit they bring to the community in terms of providing access to further education and employment opportunities.

Both the above public transport services also play an important role in reducing the need to travel by car and offering wider choices of sustainable ways of travelling, which also contributes to the reasons why they are given a score of 2 points each.

2.12 Recreation

Recreational Grounds / Children Play Area: Recreational grounds and play areas offer essential recreational opportunities and outside spaces for all to enjoy. Play areas are considered as important in ensuring that children have a safe area to play in and enjoy the outdoors, and some larger settlements may have more than one play area. Play areas are given 1 point for each provision, up-to a maximum of 5

points. As with formal sports areas, the additional provision can be on the same site, or different sites within the settlement.

Sport / Leisure Centre: Sport and Leisure centres often provide a wide range of activities and classes that are available to all; from small children, to classes specifically aimed at the elderly/disabled. They also contribute towards the economy of a settlement providing opportunity for employment and training. A score of 1 point is given to these facilities.

Allotment: Allotments are community gardens primarily used by local residents for growing fruits and vegetables. In some rural communities they also play an important role as a hub for meeting neighbours. They have grown in popularity over recent years and due to their contribution towards the vitality of a community they are included within this assessment and given a score of 1 point.

2.13 Internet Connectivity

Internet connectivity and the availability and speed of Broadband is an important issue for many rural communities. It is also an area of focus for the Government with considerable investments to improve broadband speeds. For this reason connectivity of up to 76Mb Fibre or more, which is considered to be a “super-fast speed”, is given a score of 2 points; whilst a connectivity of up to 17Mb (“standard speed”) is given 1 point.

2.14 Proximity to other settlements

This seeks to account for the situation where a smaller settlement neighbour a larger settlement and is as such largely reliant on the services and facilities contained within that neighbouring settlement. In addition larger settlements are more likely to provide a greater level of services and facilities, with smaller neighbouring settlements often only looking to compliment this offering. A settlement within 5km of a town or urban area will be given a score of 2 points, whilst a smaller settlement within 2km of an existing Core Village in Babergh or Key Service Centre in Mid Suffolk will be given 2 points.

3. Results and Conclusions

3.1 Appendix 1 shows the full results for each settlement.

3.2 Tables 2 and 3 below show the village hierarchy based on the evidence collected. Settlements scoring a total of 18 points and over are categorised as Core Villages, settlements scoring 9 to 17 points are categorised as Hinterland Villages, and settlements scoring 0 to 8 points are classified as Hamlets and Countryside, for planning policy purposes.
