Privacy Notice

Developer Contributions (Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) and section 106 (s106) obligations) are a service of Babergh & Mid Suffolk District Councils. This privacy notice explains how we use any personal information we ask you for when we are processing documents and transactions relating to CIL and s106.

What information do you collect about me?

We will collect personal and financial information about you in order to process your s106 legal agreement and payment transactions and to assess and process transactions or exemptions relating to CIL.

Why do you collect this personal and financial information and how do you use it?

Where development is chargeable under the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) Regulations 2010 (as amended) we require the information to assess your how much you will have to pay or whether you are exempt from the levy before we can issue your CIL Statutory Notices. We also collect information to help prevent fraud in relation to entitlement to exemptions. The information you provide will only be used for these purposes and we will only contact you should we require further information about your development. All of your information will be processed in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulations and may also be used by us and our partners to deliver and improve this service or to prevent fraud. We will not disclose any personal information to any other third parties unless required to do so by law. Can I access the information you hold about me?

Under the Data Protection Act, you can ask us for access to information that we hold about you. This is called a data subject access request; you will need to request this information in writing. To help you in this process we have prepared a <u>Data Subject Access Request</u> form that you can download and complete. You will be required to provide proof of identity in person. We must respond to you within one month – if we feel the request is complex we may ask for an extension of this period.

If the information is incorrect you must write to us and tell us what information is incorrect and ask that it be corrected. If we do not agree that the information is incorrect you may ask us to record your disagreement.

If you wish to complain about the way in which your request has been processed then your complaint will be dealt with as a Step two complaint in accordance with our <u>complaints procedure</u>

If, after an internal review, you are still unhappy with the decision, you have a right of appeal to the Information Commissioner, visit their page: <u>Information Commissioner</u>, report a concern
