



NOTICE OF KEY DECISION

THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES (EXECUTIVE ARRANGEMENTS) (MEETINGS AND ACCESS TO INFORMATION) (ENGLAND) REGULATIONS 2012

Notice of Key Decisions – General Exception

Regulation 9 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 requires 28 clear days' notice to be published of the Council's intention to make key decisions.

Regulation 10 (1) allows, that if it is impracticable for the Council to give the required 28 days notice, the decision may still be made if the Chairman of the Overview & Scrutiny Committee has been given notice in writing of the matter about which the decision is to be made, a copy of the notice is made available for inspection by the public and is published on the Council's website, and at least 5 clear days have elapsed following the day on which the notice is made available for inspection by the public.

Notice is hereby given under Regulation 10 (3) of the Council's intention to make a key decision at its Cabinet meeting on 11 June 2026 regarding:

Stradbroke Pool and Leisure Centre – Allocation of £235,899.90 Section 106 to facility repairs and refurbishments

The reason publication in accordance with Regulation 9 was impracticable in this case was due to: *Facility refurbishment works are scheduled to commence in June 2026 and complete by 6th August 2026.*

The proposed project is the delivery of a range of facility repairs and refurbishments at Stradbroke Pool and Leisure Centre, including roof repairs, window replacement, external lighting.

Works have been identified following the completion of a condition survey to the Leisure Centre, these works are required to extend the life of the building and complete urgent repairs such as roof leaks. On completion of the work this will benefit the community in providing a greater user experience of the services provided by the Leisure Centre.

The project will benefit users and members of Stradbroke Pool and Leisure.
