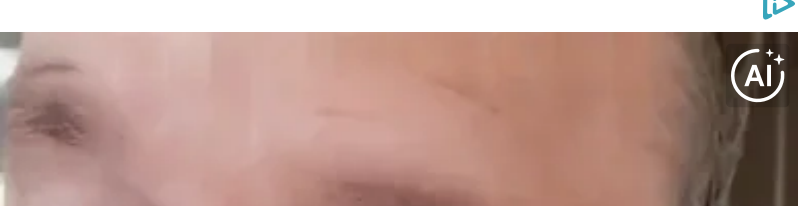

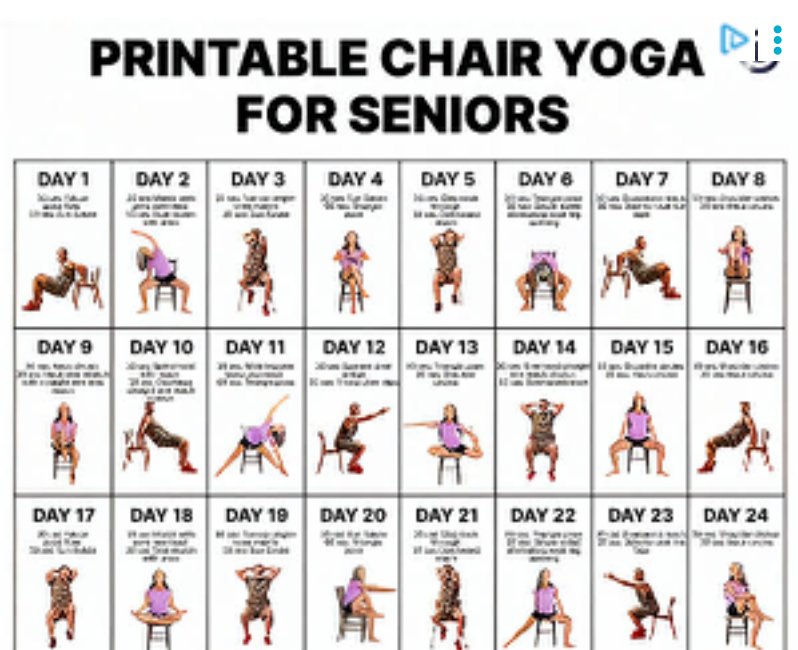

The weather had given them a good drilling season for sugar beet and other crops, but they now need rain to help them grow.

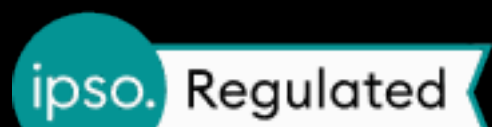
