The Proposed Conservation Area

There is currently no conservation area in Sproughton.

Whilst there has been a significant amount of new development in parts of the wider Parish, within the Village itself the historic core of the settlement remains relatively intact.

Both Sproughton Parish Council and Babergh District Council are of the opinion that the area defined above is an area of special architectural or historic interest the character and appearance of which it is desirable to preserve or enhance. It is therefore being proposed to formally ‘Designate’ a Conservation Area that would embrace all the area edged blue on the map above. [figure 1]
